DESERT HOT SPRINGS LIBRARY TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE TO PREPARE FOR RELOCATION

RIVERSIDE COUNTY, CA (April 27, 2021) – After 17 years at its current location, the 3,527 square-foot Desert Hot Springs Library will close its doors as the Riverside County Library System prepares to reopen a new facility, located at 14380 Palm Drive.

Desert Hot Springs Library will temporarily close their doors at 3:00PM on Saturday, May 1, 2021. The new home of the Desert Hot Springs Library is currently undergoing construction. The modern, 15,000 square-foot state-of-the-art library will offer enhanced services, programs, and technology to the community of Desert Hot Springs. The new library is scheduled to open in Summer 2021.
